"We were subjected to a lot of Bangor pressure in the second half, but Josh Dunn was confident in goal and deservedly earned a clean sheet," summed up Black. "The lads pulled out all the stops following Adam's dismissal against a big strong side that included a few senior players. This win is a welcome boost following back-to-back league defeats," he added.
